

B. Based on what I know, I can't uniquely determine the numbers N and M.


A. I knew that even before you told me.

#### The On-Off Switch

In the classic 1956 science fiction movie Forbidden Planet, astronauts from earth visit the planet Altair IV which is a very great distance from earth. An earlier scientific exploration team from earth came to Altair IV many years earlier but hadn't been heard from since their arrival. They find only two survivors of the earlier mission: Dr. Morbius and his scantily clad daughter played by Anne Francis. They learn that an earlier race, the Krell, were destroyed thousands of years earlier but left behind a still functioning and running enormous underground complex of nuclear reactors for almost limitless power and computers of almost limitless computational power and complexity. Morbius has gained amazing knowledge from the complex, but has unknowingly let loose horrific forces of destruction that, it turns out, are projections by the complex AI (my term, probably not used in 1956) of Morbius' own id (Freud's id was a big idea in 1956).

You may recall that Data, of *Star Trek: The Next Generation* TV series had a somewhat secret on-off switch. It appears that there was no on-off switch for the Krell's power/computer complex. It would have been very useful for the astronauts of *Forbidden Planet* had there been one, because things were clearly out of control.

A recent example of AI going awry (I'm using AI rather loosely here, for the automatic pilot of an aircraft). On December 20, 1995, American Airlines Flight 965, a Boeing 757 flying from Miami, FL and destined for Cali, Colombia, crashed into a mountain in Colombia, killing 151 out of the 155 on board. The pilots erroneously punched in a single letter "R" for a Rozo directional beacon for Cali as they flew in a valley between mountain peaks at night. Unfortunately, the autopilot interpreted this "R" as the designation for the Romeo beacon at Bogota. Just before this they had lost their exact location, and the autopilot apparently thought (if I can use that word) they were in a different valley than they actually were in. It flew them into a mountain. The cause of the accident was attributed, to a great extent, to the pilots. But the plane AI sure didn't help any.



In Dan Brown's novel *Origin*, near the end of the book, Edmond Kirsch, the world's greatest authority on AI, predicts a new race of sentient beings will soon replace humans, and they will be a merger of human beings and AI. But what kind of a being would be this merger?

> Let's suppose that it would be the most powerful intellect imaginable. But what would it be? Suppose its character was something like Adolf Hitler, or Joseph Stalin, or Mao Zedong, or Pol Pot. What then? Wouldn't it be nice if there was an on-off switch? Technology, automation, AI, etc. are wonderful servants, but horrible and inadequate taskmasters.





but these four have been with the project since 2005:


- Mid-America Mensa's Rhonda Johnson

## A discussion of some cultural differences in attitudes about sexuality.



There is enormous diversity in the range of attitudes regarding sex. Despite the undeniable fact that sex is omnipresent, a powerful drive is a requisite for our species survival and is often stigmatized and controlled. Every culture has some sort of sexual norms and taboos, that might be considered open or promiscuous by our narrow Western standards.

Interestingly there is a general decrease in societal violence that corelates directly to the level of that group's sexual freedom. This is true not only for humans, but also for one of our closest cousins the Bonobo. This species is highly sexual, and all members of the group use to mitigate aggression and violence. I would posit that our distant ancestors were much more permissive and advanced sexually than our current insecure and inhibited society.

I will proffer examples of the sexual attitudes of three disparate societies, ranging from the most, to the least repressed.

(Rural Ireland) Inis Baag is a secluded, diminutive island off the coast. Nudity is disdained and considered shameful. The residents will not even remove clothing to bathe and wash only exposed flesh. Even during sex, both partners will keep on at least their undergarments.

Premarital sex is rare and female orgasm is almost unheard of. The husband always initiates sex with no foreplay other than perhaps squeezing of the buttocks. The missionary position is always utilized and the man is expected to ejaculate quickly, roll over, and go to sleep. Sex is not engaged in often as it is rumored to drain a man's strength. Women fear menstruation and men avoid them accordingly. Menopause is looked upon with dread as it is considered a portent of insanity. Sex education is non-existent as couples are expected to figure it out naturally.

(Central Brazil) The people of the village of Mehinaku have lots of sex but also suffer from anxiety caused by the repercussions of those interactions. The culture is very eroticized and even the children know of sexual matters. The genders are generally separate, and a woman must never snoop around a man's house lest she be gang raped. In all other aspects, the society is remarkably non-violent.

Even married men openly vie for a woman's favor, usually by presenting her a small gift. Men are the sexual initiator as women are viewed to have an inferior sex drive. Even though extra-marital liaisons are deemed inappropriate by cultural standards they still occur, and fantastical punishments await those who deviate. Female orgasm is generally rare, and menstruation is understood to be dangerous. Dreams are interpreted to provide guidance in sexual matters. Though these people experience intense anxiety over their exploits, it does little to dissuade their continued activities.

**(South Pacific)** The Mangaian islanders and Polynesian cultures in general enjoy a much greater sexual freedom than we are accustomed to. Not only is sex used for procreation it is considered a vital life force and necessary social lubricant. Nudity is totally normal, and the body is considered beautiful. Sexual discovery is considered a part of development and is not repressed, and in fact it is encouraged.

The concept of shame did not exist until the arrival of the European barbarians. The genitals were considered holy and treated with reverence and respect. It was not taboo for adults of either gender to engage minors in sex for purposes of instruction or otherwise. Most children were initiated at an early age and by all accounts were eager participants.

At age 7, a Mangaian boy begins learning about his sexuality and is encouraged to explore his genitalia and start masturbating by 8 or 9. In preparation for a boy's later coming of age surgery, at birth an elder female blows into the child's penis to stretch the foreskin making it easier to slit.

This daily ritual is reduced in frequency when a boy is old enough to urinate in an arch. When he reaches 13, the boy undergoes a rite of passage into manhood ceremony. His penis is mutilated via superincision and he is instructed in the finer arts of manhood by elders. Performed similarly to a circumcision, the procedure is called a dorsal slit, the foreskin is cut along its entire length from the tip to the corona.

After 2 weeks of healing, the boy is assigned to an older woman who will instruct him in the arts of adulthood. They practice multiple positions and techniques and she teaches him to withhold ejaculation until after his partner has achieved orgasm. A man is taught that his primary source of pleasure is to bring satisfaction to his mate. The average boy will have at least 10 different partners prior to marriage and will actively seek out females on a nightly basis. Most young Mangaian men will orgasm 3 times a night, although the frequency diminishes as they age.

Soon after birth, a Mangaian girl has her mother's breast milk squirted into her vagina and her vulva pressed flat and massaged with coconut oil. This was intended to aid in her future fertility. The labia are stretched and elongated by being sucked on by the mother and other attendant females. Other related Oceanic societies would also elongate and sensitize the clitoris by similar methods.



Around 12, a Mangaian girl starts receiving formal sexual instruction and actively explores her sexuality. She is expected to have several boyfriends before her marriage at

around 20. Parents know that the marriage is only successful if both partners are sexually compatible. Older women stretch the young girl's labia to make them more attractive. A grandmother is responsible for breaking a girl's hymen so that her first time would not hurt nor would she get blood on her lover. Young girls are taught to use their bodies in such a way as to provide the maximum pleasure for their partner, including the art of rhythmically constricting the vaginal musculature. Once menarche is attained and pubic hair became evident, a girl covers her genitals but goes bare breasted.

Both boys and girls play together until around 6 or 7, then they congregate separately. Youth of both sexes and all ages are expected to explore the other person's genitals and engage in heterosexual and homosexual mutual masturbation and/or other types of sex play.

A man or woman rumored to be a selfish or a lazy lover would face community ridicule, while a skillful lover was much lauded and admired.

For adults, foreplay is almost non-existent with both parties engaging in coitus almost immediately after meeting, but both usually achieve an orgasm.

Homosexuality is accepted and not stigmatized as is pretty much any form of sexual encounter that can be envisaged.

This society is blessedly free from most of the violence that engenders our species although it is not totally utopian. Females who refuse sex can be raped or even beaten, although this behavior is now rare. Sex is the salve that eases societal interactions, the cement that holds together the culture and helps to deflect the scourge of aggression. We could learn much from them!
